 assigns shall and will from time to time and at all times hereafter during the space  
 of seven years at the Request and at the proper costs & Charges in the Law of him  
 the said Thomas Innes his heirs & assigns make due acknowledgement Executors & suffer or  
 act or acts thing or things done or done as aforesaid or whatsoever requisite  
 in the premises for the better and former conveying and more sure making of the said  
 bargained premises unto him the said Thomas Innes his heirs and assigns for ever so  
 it by involvement of these presents find suffment or otherwise or by any other such  
 lawful ways or means as by him the said Thomas Innes his heirs or assigns or his Councils
