 and upon Petitions of Certificate of such Surveyors to him the said
 Henry Darvall to be past grant or grants thereof in my Name
 in the usual Manner under my great Seale of my Province of
 Maryland as in my booke signing the same And to cause the
 Registers to be Made of such his proceedings in the same Manner
 as they have done for the said Province in that province taking into
 consideration such fees and rewards as usually have been taken & provided
 for in the like Matter there And the said Henry Darvall to
 grant speciall warrants und^r my hand & my great Seale for the
 Surveying any tract or parcel of Land within that province And if
 any Surveyor thereupon shall be found to sell and Dispose thereof to
 my use in such Manner as to him shall seeme Meete to pass grant
 or grants thereof und^r my great Seale in Manner aforesaid of part or
 upon Surrender of the grant of the Land or such Surrender to include
 by a New grant the surplus in the whole & regarding what usually
 they have done in such Cases heretofore And the said Henry Darvall
 to do all other Act and Act thing and thing pursuant to the
 Ordinary of plantation afore named and to execute all and every the
 Powers Authorities and Instructions by me L^{et} given and granted to my
 said Council for Land Affairs and to the Council for Land in a
 full and ample Manner as the said Council might or ought by virtue
 of the said powers Authorities and Instructions to have done & as if the
 same had been here particularly mentioned and named And if the
 Surveyors committing and making by all former Commissions Authorities
 Powers and Instructions touching the premises to any other person or
 persons by me or my Authority formerly given this Commission &
 the powers hereby granted to continue During my pleasure
 Given at London und^r my Great Seale at Armes this thirteenth
 Day of December in the year of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ
 one thousand six hundred Ninety and five

This Indenture made the 16th Day of May in the year of our Lord one
 thousand six hundred ninety and five between John Lord of the County of Baltimore
 in the province of Maryland Mariner the son and sole heir of the said John Lord
 of the Kingdom of England Mariner Son of the one part and Richard
 Wood of the County of Anne Arundell in the province aforesaid of
 the other part Witness that whereby the said John Lord Baltimore
 by his Deed of grant or patent und^r my great Seale then used in the
 province of Maryland for granting of Land there bearing Date at the
 City of St. Marys the one and twentieth Day of November Anno Domini 1676
 did for the Consideration therein mentioned Grant unto the said J^o Body
 Mariner All that parcel of Land called Bodys Adven hard lying in Baltimore
 County on the South side of Palapscoo River & on the North side of Curas
 Branch of Curtis Creek beginning at a bounded Hickory being the Corner
 End of the west South west End of the Land formerly laid out for one
 Joseph Moorly called Moorly's Choice & running South South East one hundred
