

This Indenture made the day of November Anno Domini 1695 Between Richard Medrall of the one part and Robert Wansorke of Wm Arundell County Lawyer on the other part witnesseth that the said Richard Medrall doth hereby promise and promise and grants to and with the said Robert Wansorke his Executors and Assignes from the day of the date hereof until the full time and term of four years to be completed and ended and in consideration whereof the said Robert Wansorke doth hereby promise and grant to and with the said Richard Medrall to learn him the Trade of a Lawyer and to learn him the said Richard Medrall to read and write and to find and allow him Meat Drink Apparel and Lodging and other necessary during the said term and to the said Richard Medrall is to send for and to do necessary jobs about the plantation and at the end of the four years the said Robert Wansorke is to pay the said Medrall three pounds Sterling money of England and one good Suit of Apparel of Serge or good Kersey In witness whereof the parties above mentioned to these Indentures have interchangeably set their hands and Seals this day and year above written.
