and Nathaniel Barnin he removed to New England w^{ch} is about twenty and two Years since w^{ch} whom they have bene
well acquainted ever since & that the said M^r Mary and Nathaniel Barnin were & only reputed for the said
M^r Nathaniel Barnin as aforesaid and that the said Mary Barnin was married to M^r Timothy Sindall about thirtie Years
past and as yet surviving and hath many children, but her brother Nathaniel Barnin as the said Deponents are Inform
ed is lately deceased at Virginia without Issue.
