 of money, rents, Arrearages, and Remains of Rents, goods wares, Chattell Chattell or other Estates  
 whatsoever; which is and others after shall be due, owing belonging or Appertaining unto us or either of us, by  
 any manner of wayes or means whatsoever, And for default of payment and delivery of the said Debtors  
 or other person or persons whatsoever who holding or detaining the same to sue Arrest Attach Imprison and  
 Condemn, sue and their bodies, Sums & Sums of goods and Chattell in Execution to take and out of Execution  
 against to deliver, And also to compound and agree as need shall require And upon Satisfaction  
 Composition or otherwise at the discretion of our said Attorney acquittance or other discharge in due form of law  
 to make Seals or deliver. And if need be to appear before any Judges Justices or Magistrates in any  
 Court or Courts of Judicature and there to answer for us, and in our names and behalves, in all Actions matters  
 and things depending or to be depending in Law barran or controversy between us or either of us the  
 Constituants and other persons whatsoever And more Generally to act manage transact and negotiate  
 all matters and things relating to the premises as fully and Effectually as we or either of us might or could
