between Anthony Workman of Kent Island in Talbot County in the Province of Maryland gent: and Jean his wife, of  
the one part, and Morris Slavery of the fo. County place and Province aforesaid Planter, of the other part Witnesse, That  
P. Anthony Workman and Jean his wife, for and in Consideration of the sum of thirty Seven pounds and ten shillings  
current money to him the P. Anthony Workman paid by the P. Morris Slavery at and before the Enbaling and delivery  
of these present Indentures whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and thereof he doth hereby acquit and discharge the Morris  
Slavery his heire & son by these presents, hath given granted Bargain'd and sold and by these presents, doth give grant  
Bargain and sell unto him the P. Morris Slavery his heire and assignes all that tract and parcell of Land called  
Timber Ridge situate lying & being on the Island of Kent in the province aforesaid that it to say all that is within the  
Bounds hereafter specified, clear of any Ante-here Survey then the date of this fo. Indenture wch. is the 19th between the  
head of Piggwater Creek begining at a marked white Oak in the Woods running for Broad St North East  
hundred and forty poarches to another marked white Oak standing by a swamp Rod and from the P. White Oak  
and drawn west North west for length one hundred eighty and eight poarches, then by a line drawn from the  
of the west North west line, south sou: west two hundred and forty poarches, then by a straight line drawn to  
first marked white Oak containing and now laid out for two hundred fifty acres: together with all Right  
and profits or Benefits theromto belonging or in any wayes appertaining or entomring thefo. promised or any  
or parcell therof, To have and to hold the said tract or parcell of Land with all and singular the Rights and  
members and appurtenances theromto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said Morris Slavery
