This Indenture made the nineteenth day of Octob. in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred ninety and seven
 between Anthony Workman of Kent Island in the Province of Maryland Gent. and Joan his wife, of
 the one part, and Mary Slavy of the J. County place and Province aforesaid. Planter, of the other part Witnesseth, That
 J. Anthony Workman and Joan his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of thirty seven pounds and ten shillings
 current Money to him the J. Anthony Workman paid by the J. Morris Slavy at and before the Enbaling and delivery
 of those J. Harris the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledg and thereof he doth hereby acquit and discharge the J. Morris
 Slavy his heirs & Adm. by those J. Harris, hath given granted Bargain and sold and by those J. Harris, doth give grant
 Bargain and sell unto him the J. Morris Slavy his heirs and assigns all that tract and parcel of Land called
 Amber Ridge situate lying & being on the Island of Kent in the Province aforesaid. that is to say all that is within the
 Bounds hereafter specified. Bear of any Antient Survey then the date of the J. Harris is both between the
 head of pigqueter & faced creek beginning at a marked white Oak in the Wood priming for Broadth North North East
 hundred and forty poarches to another marked white Oak standing by a Swamp Red and from the J. White Oak
 line drawn west North west for length one hundred eighty and eight poarches, then by a line drawn from the
 of the West north west line, South Sou: west two hundred and forty poarches, then by a straight line drawn to
 first bounded white Oak, containing and now laid out for two hundred fifty acres: together with all Right
 and profits or Benefits thereunto belonging or in any wayes appertaining or containing the J. Harris or any
