By his Exy the Gov and Council together with the Representatives of this Province appointed a Committee to inspect and examine all Accounts of the Revenue raised within this Province for the Support of Government from the Beginning of the Revolution in the Year 1690 untill the Arrival of his Exy Francis Nicholson Esq their Majties Gov into this Province which was in July in the Year 1694 in ffiance of which wee have used our utmost Care and Diligence by which wee find there has been paid and Delivered into the hands of Genl Copley Esq their Majties late Gov by severall Officers the severall Sums by Bills of Exchange and otherwise hereafter Mentioned

As also the severall Sums of Money Goods and Bills of Exchange part of the said Revenue made use of and expended by Mr John Cook and Mr Kendall Esq Agents for this Province as by their Accounts herewith presented may more fully appear Having perused all such Books Accounts loose and confused papers as by any means wee could procure and also the said Accounts wee find from the Officers now living which were appointed for collecting and receiving the sd Revenue within the said Province By all which wee find the said Genl Copley late Gov to have received and taken into his hands the severall Sums by Bills of Exchange and otherwise as hereafter Mentioned amounting to the sum of ———— 2316:12:11
