Be it known unto all Men by these presents that I William Coppe of London Merchant (in the Behalf of Myself and on behalf of the Owners of the Ship Jefferys) have made Ordained Constituted and appointed and by these presents doe make Ordained Constituted and appointed my Loving friend Mr Richard Bennett of Talbot County in the Province of Maryland Merchant my true and Lawfull atty for me in my Name and Name and to my use (and the use of the Owners of the said Ship) to ask demand sue for Levy receive and receive of and from Mr William Sharp of Talbot County and his Heirs and all and every or any other person or persons whatsoever within the said Province whom it doth may or shall concern all such Tobacco Sum or Sums of Money paid all Debts as is or and or shall or may be due owing pending or belonging to me and the Owners of the said Ship from the said William Sharp or any other person or persons whatsoever within the said Province for or by reason or means or in respect of any Bond Bill Act or other Act Matter Cause or thing whatsoever touching and by these presents granting unto my said atty my full power and Lawfull and absolute Authority in and touching the said atty or any of the said to doe say sue implead prosecute pursue seize arrest Attach Imprison and to Condemne and out of Prison to Deliver and to Compromise agree Acquitt Release and discharge and to do or cause to be done under him to substitute or appoint and at his pleasure to do and generally to do or cause to be done and accomplish all and every or any other Lawfull and reasonable Act Matter Cause or thing whatsoever as shall be meett needfull or expedient to be done in or about the said atty as fully and effectually wth full power and power as I myself might or lawfully doe the said atty or the said substitute shall Lawfully doe or cause to be done in or about the said atty or any of the said to the life and I doe and will Ratifye and Confirm if Law for ever by these presents In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this first day of May Anno Domini 1698 and in the tenth year of the Reigne of our Sovereign Lord King William the third of England
