 28:30:11 hogheads of Maryland Tobacco in Cask being marked and numbered as in the margin, as
 to be Delivered in the like good order and well conditioned all by aforesaid Port of London or
 Holland (the Danger of the Seas Excepted) unto M^o Micajah Berry upon the proper Account
 and Charge of M^o Thomas Lawson or to his Assignes he or they paying freight for the goods
 seven pounds Sterl. for England or eight pounds Sterl. for Holland to be primage and charges
 accustomed In witness whereof the master or purser of the said Ship hath Affirmed to these
 bills of Lading, all of this tenor and Date, Given at W^o three bills being Accomplished, this
 the twelfth day of July and God God send the good Ship to her Desired port in Safety, Amen,
 he or they paying Maryland Duties Duties in Boluxant this 5th of July 1698

Maryland Knows all men by these presents that I George Blater of the Province of Maryland Esq^r in
 Consideration of the Sum of the hundred pounds Sterl. Lawfull Money of England already in my
 hands before the Expaling and Delivery of these presents, wherewith I have of my selfe purchased
 and paid have bargained and sold, and by these presents doo fully clearly and absolutely bargain
 sell unto M^o Benjamin Hatley of London Merchant his heirs Ex^o Admin^o or certain Att^{ys}
 Eight Negroes Slaves viz^t three men and five Women commonly knowne and by me called by the
 names of Jack Madagasco Jack and Robm the five Women names as follows Black Hannah Maria
 Betty Agatha and Hester To have and to hold y^e said Eight Negroes to y^e M^o Benjamin
 Hatley his Ex^o Admin^o or Assignes to his and their owne proper Use for Ever and in case
 any of the afores^d Negroes should dye before the said Hatley or his Att^{ys} soth forth them away
 from off my Plantation then and such Case y^e said Hatley or his Att^{ys} to purchase one or more Negroes
 to supply y^e Places of such Deceased Negroes to y^e number of Eight AND y^e said George
 Blater my heirs Ex^o or Admin^o am hereby bound and doo here by promise to Defend and make
 good y^e said Eight Negroes to y^e said Hatley or his Attorney Ex^o or Admin^o for Ever, against all
 people and to provide for y^e said Hatley or his Att^{ys} (In Case I have them not) good Sufficient
 Negroes for him to take his Choice of, In Case of Death of any of them before to be away as
 afo^o and a good and Sufficient Title to them for Ever to Defend by these presents In Witness
 whereof I have sett my hand and Seale this Twelvth day of July In the tenth Year of the
 Reigne of our Sovereigne Lord King W^m the third Annoq³ Domini 1698
