 Major John Hammond of Maryland Merchant in and Law full Authority giving unto the said John Bria and in Case
 of his Mortality as aforesaid to the said Major Hammond full Power full Authority for and in my Name and to my Heirs
 ask demand sue for recover and receive all and singular such Sum and Sums of Money Tobaccoes and other Merchants
 vices Efforts and things what soever as are or shall be due Owning and Belonging to me by or from any Person or Persons
 whatsoever in Maryland and together with all the Damages and Intrests touching the said Debts to Account from
 pound Pound and Agreed by Arbitration or any other Amicable Means as shall be Decreed for my most and Best
 Profit and Advantage upon Recovery and receipt to me and give due and Sufficient Acquittance and discharge
 and if need be to the said Major Hammond or his Assigns or Attorneys and Executors and Administrators and all of them against whom
 need shall require to be done and one or more to make and substitute in all or any the saids and him or them
 against at pleasure to send and send to do say transact and accomplish in this behalf as well in Judge Court as without
 what soever my self might or could do lawfully I do hereby promising to hold and satisfy for good and valid what soever
 the said John Bria in Case of his Mortality the said Major John Hammond shall lawfully do or cause to be done by
 virtue hereof in witness whereof I the said Benjamin Halby have hereunto set my hand and Seal at London this
 seven and twentieth day of the Month of December Anno Domini 1697 and in the ninth Year of the Reigne of William the third of
 England King
