 Ports of London the Danger of the Seas only Excepted unto Micajah Berry Merchant in London or his
 Assignes he or they paying Freight, for y^e P^r Goods at y^e Rate of T^{en} shillings p^r Tunn of Maryland
 Dulys with fumage and average Customes. In witness whereof, the Master or parser of the Said
 Ship hath affirmed to three bills of Lading all of this tenor and Date, the one of which three bills
 being Accomplished the other two to Stand void, and So God Send the good Ship to her desired

 Lord the King his heirs and Successors We bind our selves and each of us our and every of our heirs Ex^{ts} and
 Adm^{rs} Jointly and Severally firmly by these presents as with our hands and Seals this 26th Day of September
 in the Eight year of his Majesty King Charles the second Anno Domini 1698

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound George Muschamp E^g is by his Matys
