Whereas the above bound Dinah Nuthhead having for her petition humbly Supplicated his Ex^{ty} the Govern^r for Leave and Licence to sett up her printing press for printing of blank bills bonds writts warrants of Att^{ny} &c of Administration and other necessary blankes usefull for publicque Offices of this Province, which being referred to the Assembly and there approved too, and by his Ex^{ty} and Council accordingly Ordered The giving bond &c

Now the Condition of this obligation is Such that if the S^d Dinah Nuthhead shall Exercise and employ her printing press and Letters in no other use than for the printing of blank bills bonds writts warrants of Attorney Letters of Administration and other like blankes as above - nor suffer any other person to make up thereof any otherwise than as aforesaid unless by a particular Licence from his Ex^{ty} the Govern^r first had and obtained and further shall save harmless and indemnified his said Ex^{ty} the Govern^r from any damage that may hereafter ensue by the said Dinahs misapplying or suffering to be misapplied the aforesaid printing press or Letters otherwise than to the true intent and meaning before Expressed Then this obligation to be void & goe to remain in full force and Virtue
