Maryland Know all men by these presents that wee William Staden Edward Dorsy and Charles Carroll gent are lawfully bound unto our Sovereign Lord King William the third or in the full right Sum of five hundred pounds sterling to the use payment whereof to be made unto our said Sovereign Lord the King his heirs and assigns wee bind ourselves and every of our heirs, Exors and assigns severally and jointly for the whole and in the whole firmly by these presents sealed and dated this 21st of December 1697

The condition of this obligation is such that if the above bound William Staden who is appointed the Collector of the Port and district of Annapolis shall well and faithfully execute the said Office and receive a just and true account of and pay the one penny of every pound of him to be received according to his Majesty's Royall Grant and Charter to the College of William and Mary in his Colony of Virginia and observe and fulfill the Directions and Instructions of the Hon^{ble} his Majesty's Commissioners of the Customs throughout and shall all soe observe and fulfill all such other Instructions as he shall from time to time receive from the said Council of the Customs in England or from his Ex^{ty} the Gov^{er} of this Province for y^e time being then this obligation to be void otherwise in full paid and discharged
