whole jointly by these presents witness our hands and seals this 25 day of March 1695

The condition of this Obligation is such that whereas his Majesty Francis Nicholson Esq. hath by Commission and
appointed the said Daniell Peire to be viewing Surveyor of Cecil County and the Counties therunto adjacent within the
said Province by his Commission bearing date the 5th day of March 1695 Now if the said Daniell Peire shall well
and truly perform the said Office according to the severall Acts of Parliament and Laws of this Province unto
which by his said Commission he is referred to be guided by as also shall observe and follow all such directions &
Instructions as from time to time shall receive from the said Francis Nicholson Esq. and from time to time
harmless to the said Francis Nicholson Esq. from all Damages Loss and Charges that he the said Francis Nicholson
Esq. shall sustain at any time by reason of the said Peires run & demands of his said Office so long as he shall
enjoy the said as in the severall Laws is Enacted and Ordained upon the above Obligation to be void and of None
Effect otherwise to be and Remains in full force and virtue

Lord King William or his heirs and Assigns to the which payment well and truly to be made wee and our selfs our heirs Ex^{ty}
and Adms and every of them severally and jointly for the whole and in the whole jointly by these presents -
Sealed and dated at the Port of Annapolis this four and twentieth day of December 1697

The condition of this Obligation is such that whereas the above bounden William Byrd is by the Hon^{ble} Edward Reade
Esq. Surveyor Genl of his Majesties Colonies on the Continent of America and Islands adjacent appointed and Deputed to be Viewing
Surveyor not only in the Rivers of Do-Buick and Sappas but also on the heads of all the Rivers on the Eastern Shore unto
Susquahanah River If he the said William Byrd shall well and faithfully execute and discharge the said Office and observe and
follow all such orders and instructions as he shall from time to time receive from the Hon^{ble} the Lords of his Majesties Colonies at the
Customs house in London in the Kingdom of England or from the Lords of his Majesties Colonies and from his Majesty Genl of Maryland for
the time being and from the Surveyor Genl of his Majesties Colonies of the Continent of America and Islands adjacent and in all things
relating to his said Office honestly and faithfully demean himself that then this obligation to be void otherwise in full force and virtue
