as also the Ord^r of Council what you are now to send in upon that money which
is 331: 2: 2: 3/4: as you will see by the acct. here stated, Includ^d is a letter I have
written to our Capt. Silver & desire that you will give your self the trouble to find
him out, and he will inform you where you may have the best Granadior arms,
get him to god with you to look upon them and to give you his opinion whether
they be right good or not; and also to give you written directions for using & Granadi^{er}
arms and to make the ffuz: for the Granado shells, for all which you must let
him satisfied for his trouble out of the afores^d. 331: 2: 2: 3/4: If the P. Capt. Silver
should be dead you will do well to apply yo^r. self to the Chief Gunner, and when
you have bought the arms & ammunition in the first part of the Ord^r wanting
you are to dispose of the rest of the money according to the latter part of the Ord^r
in Granadior and Dragoons arms &c. — which is what is needfull from
