 intrusions and incumbrances what so ever, and of and from all other charges tithes troubles and
 incumbrances what so ever had made committed, or willingly or unwillingly suffered to be done by the
 William Medley or by any other person or persons what so ever lawfully claiming by force or under
 colour by this means or in any other manner the same and fruits from henceforth to grow due and
 payable to the said Stephen Murly and his heirs and assigns And the said William Medley for himself
 his heirs and assigns all and singular the before bargains and premises with all appurtenances and every
 part and parcel thereof unto the said Stephen Murly his heirs and assigns or assigns to the use and
 behoofe of the said estate shall and will warrant and for ever defend by the said p. p. rights in witness whereof the

 they shall think right or could do if they were personally present, and joyfully and freely upon
 receiving thereof acquittance and other discharge for me and in my name to make, seal & deliver
