This Indenture made the thirty first day of August in the ninth year of the Reign of
William the third by the grace of God of England Justice Francis and Justice King Deputie of the faithfull
and in the year of our Lord according to the Supplication of the Church of England 1637. Between Robert Vaulx
of the County of Dorchester in the province of Maryland in America Planter and Elizabeth his wife of one part
and Stephen Faulx of the County of York in the Colony of Virginia of the other parts Witnesseth that
Said Robert Vaulx and Elizabeth his wife for Divers good causes and considerations them thus unto moving
but more especially for and in consideration of forty pounds good and Lawfull of England unto them by Said
Stephen Faulx in hand paid at and before of Enrolling and delivery of these presents by Receipt wherof and of
Every parte therof the Said Robert Vaulx and Elizabeth his wife do hereby acknowledge & shew of our
fully freely and absolutely for themselves their heirs Ex^{rs} & Adm^{rs} and Every of them Exonerate acquit
and Discharge the Said Stephen Faulx his heirs Ex^{rs} and Adm^{rs} by these presents Have Granted
Bargained Sold Remised Released and Confirmed and by these presents for themselves and either of them their
and Every of their heirs Respectively do Grant bargain Sell Remise Release and for Ever Confirmed unto the
Said Stephen Faulx and to his heirs and Assignes for Ever all and singular the Right Title Title Interest
use Possession reversion Claim and Demand what so ever which they the Said Robert Vaulx & Elizabeth his
wife or either of them Ever had have or which hereafter they or either of them their or either of any of their
heirs for or may Claim to have of and in two certain Sealed Tracts or Divisions of Land containing two
hundred and fifty acres Situate Lying and being in the Said County of York in Virg^{ia} of now already in
actuall and peaceable Possession of him the Said Stephen Faulx by virtue of a bargain Sold and Donif
to him made by Indenture Dated the day before the Date of these presents for three years then next coming and
by virtue of the Statute for transferring Uses into possession which said two hundred and fifty acres is bound
as followeth that is to say one hundred and fifty acres parts therof lying and being in the parish of Bruton
formerly manor pish of the Uppermost Side of Quorum Creek and according to the metes and bounds ascertained
in one pattern for y^e Said one hundred and fifty acres of land granted unto John Davies Dated y^e twenty first
Day of October 1649. thus bounded to wit beginning at a marked tree and running along the Land thence
into the corner of y^e Towne South by East one Quarter Easterly fifty six Chances thence west three quarters
along the
