 the Schedule hereunto Annexed) with all and every other my goods, rights, credits, and Estates whatso
 ever either real or personall in Maryland aforesaid consisting in Lands, Plantations, Houses, Stock Woods
 Underwoods, workhouses, rents, royalties, and remainders, or otherwise howsoever belonging to mee, either in my own
 right, or by Donation of my Said late Husband Edward Lloyd Dec^d, or as I am Ex^{ca} of his last will and
 Testament, or otherwise, together with all my right, title Interest, Claim, property & Demand whatsoever
 of, in, and to the Said Scheduled Debts, and other my Estates whatso ever either real or personall as aforesaid
 in the Said Province of Maryland, or of, in, and to any part or parts thereof I have and will
 all and Singular the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be hereby bargained and Sold, with
 appurtenances to the Said Richard Bennett, his heirs Ex^{ca} Adm^{rs} and Assignes, to his and their own
 use and uses, and his and their own proper Goods and Chattels from hence forth freely for ever, with
 Warranty ag^t all persons claiming or to claim any right, or title therunto by, from, or Under mee the Said Graue
