

Such offender be in our Actual Service and come on and in pay on board any such our Ships of war or other  
 vessels acting by Immediat Commission or warrant from our Commissioners for executing the Office of our  
 high Admirall or our high Admirall as soe farre as he shall receyue any Protection for the avoiding of Justice  
 for such Offences committed on board from any pretence of his being employed in our Servitall Sea weedoe  
 hereby give you full power and Authority to appoynt Hayes Mart and Marlettes as allsoe such and for many  
 Ports Harbours Bays Havens and other places for the convenient and Surety of Shipping and for the better Loading  
 and Unloading of Goods and Merchandizes as by you with the advice and Consent of the said Councill shall be  
 thought fit and necessary and in them or any of them to erect Nominall and Appoynt Officers knift Board  
 Ships and Officers relating therunto and how to alter Change or displace them wher as with the advice aforesaid  
 shall be thought fit we do further by these presents command you to take all possible Care for the discoueraunce  
 of vice and encouragement of Virtue and good living that by such Examples the Justitie may be Justed and  
 defende to persue of the Christian Religion And we do hereby require and command all Officers Civil and Military  
 and all other Inhabitants of our said Province and Territory to be obedient Obedient and obeying unto you the said  
 Francis Nicholson in the Execution of this our Commission and of the Powers and Authoritie therin contained  
 and in case of your Death or absence out of our said Province to be obedient Obedient and obisting unto such Personas shall  
 be appoynted by us to be Commander in Chief to whom we do therfore by these presents Give and Grant all and  
 Singular the powers and Authoritie aforesaid to be Executed and used by him during our Pleasure or until your Com-  
 mand within our said Province of Maryland Provided alwayes that Nothing herein contained shall be construed  
 or taken to diminish or alter the Powers formerly Granted to our selfe and well beloved Sir Edward Andros Knight  
 Your Commission unto him bearing date the third day of March and thareafter the hundred thirtie and iiii the fourth  
 year of our Raigne but that the said Sir Edward Andros upon his Death or absence from America of you the said  
 Francis Nicholson shall take upon him the Chiefe Command of our said Province and execute the Powers of this our  
 Commission as we do hereby likewise will and command that our Commission bearing date the fourteenth day of  
 November in the first year of our Raigne Entiteling you our Lieutenant Gove of our Dominion and Colony of  
 Virginia doe cease and determine from the date of these Presents upon the Death or absence from America  
 of the said Sir Edward Andros For which cause our will and pleasure is that you take upon you the Chiefe Command  
 of our said Dominion and execute the Powers of our Commission given to the said Sir Edward Andros untill our  
 further pleasure be knowne And if upon his death or absence of you the said Francis Nicholson out of our said  
 Province of Maryland then be we then Commissioned or appoynted by us to be Commander in Chief of our said  
 Province our will and Pleasure is that the hon. Councill of that our Province doe take upon them the administration  
 of the Government and execute this Commission and the several Powers and Authoritie therin contained and that  
 the first Councillor who shall be at the time of your Death or absence residing within our Province of Maryland doe provide  
 inward Council with such Powers and Authoritie as any former Plaintiff hath had and enjoyed within our said Pro-  
 vince or any other our Plantations in America untill our pleasure be further knowne or you arrivall as aforesaid We  
 do hereby declare Ordaine and appoynt that you the said Francis Nicholson shall and may hold execute and enjoy the  
 Office and place of Captain Generall and Governor in Chief in and over our Province and Territory of Maryland together wth all  
 and Singular the Powers thereby Granted unto you for and during our selfe and pleasure In witness whereof we have  
 caused to be made these letters late made at Baltimore in the County of Baltimore the tenth day of July in the fifth year  
 of our Raigne
