The Condition of this Obligation is such that whereas his Excy Francis Nicholson Esq[ue] hath depited and appointed the above said  
Mathew Ward to be Deputy Et[al] of Talbot County under M[ar]thas Lawrence Sheriff of the said County Novemb[er] Maj 1693 Servitor  
at Sea and hath therby committed to him Care and Charge and Custody all the Books Et[al] Rolls and papers to his said County and Belon-  
ging or appertaining Now if the said Mathew Ward doe in all things according to the Duty and trust required in him  
of Deputy Et[al] aforesaid and faithfully discharge the same and the said Books Et[al] Rolls Deeds and Writings therunto be-  
longing doe well and truly keep and preserve and his Subjects and Books of all proceedings of the said Court doe well  
and faithfully make and enter without fraud Contraire or delay and affise yearly during his said Continuance  
in the said Office make out his and off[er]ed Accou[n]ts of all fees growing due to the Et[al] of the said Court and transmitt the  
same to the Excy the G[ener]al without Diminution or Contraire at or upon the last day of December in every year then his
