 do hereby certify unto the Right Honourable and most illustrious Lord the Lord Baltimore of  
 Baltimore absolute Lord and Proprietor of the Province of Maryland that in the City of  
 to all others whom they see shall or may concern that the said James Ogato a Black  
 (whom we verily in former and given to under hand) was first born of Black Parents at  
 Somerwick near London in the Kingdom of England, and there baptiz'd in the Christian  
 faith, and was thence brought down to the City of Durham by one Mr. William Gordon a  
 late Alderman of this City, where he was baptiz'd by a Minister (his then Mistress being  
 a Quaker Catholic) and that to our knowledge he had lived divers years with the said Wm Gordon  
 as his servant or boy in the Trade of working Tobacco) until his death (he being then  
 Mayor of this City) and that after his said Masters death he returned to London to his Mistress  
 from whence the said William Gordon had him in his Company whereof was the said Mayor and Aldermen  
 and he returned to his said City and after the death of the said Mayor and Aldermen  
 the said day of December in the fourth year of the said King our said Province Anno Domini  
 Charles the second the said Ogato did come to the said City and there he lived for  
 seven years.

 in the premises as fully amply & as largely as if I my self were personally
