If whereas there haue of late been many Scandalous and Defamatory Rumours and Stories Shred up in this Brodine but more p:icularly in St: Marys County tending to disquarl and trouble of this his may ^{his} happy Government, And which said Reports its much much Doubteth many of his may ^{his} good and prauable Subjects haue been much annoyed and abused by false notions and apprehensions so if not speedily remov'd may tend to great damage and punishment of such persons not less than disquarl of this Brodine It is same things having already brought severall persons to condigne punishment And will undoubtely be the portion of all others that shall passe in such Evills: And for as much as y: Ex: of hale of your goodness ^{my} Condescended so far as to lay before C: Court and County, lately at Annapolis to a very great number of severall Rumours and Reports that haue of late been invented and spread abroad ag: his his may ^{his} Govr: and made them all appear by Records and other Undenyable Proofs to be some faled Persons Scandalous and all malitious to full satisfaction and beyond Contradiction in y: mind of all persons y: Gent and to y: conviction of the: Considered In God much that it has been Represented to y: Ex: and your Ex: prayed to His forth Proclamations through this Brodine therby disabuse his may ^{his} good Subjects and to tell them in peace and quiet and also to caution and leare to ouer Excuse all such who by these gentle Remonstrances will not be reclaims and to lett all know those very persons who were y: actors and Principles therin and to sensible of y: malitious and will therof that they haue mad afull acknowledgement and entered into Solemn Engagem: to aby^d and abandon y: like for y: future We do therefore humbly pray your Ex: that it may be published proclaims and made knowne that all y: Said Rumours and Stories are faled Scandalous and malitious invented and spread abroad by John Ford as principle author and others that haue suffered thereby and to probablie would y: Said Ford also but that he is fled into Virg: And how harboured w^t whom his may ^{his} good Subjects may be command and required not onely to forbeare Affilating and Combining but to forbeare and offend him If hee soever found in this Brodine and County to y: next Justis of peace to be sent to y: Sherif of y: County according to a former Proclamation and w^t do his sw: and Ex: that all persons will take warning and thereby cautioned ag: Such practice for y: faled it appening to us that your Ex: is desirous and inclined rather to Caution and Events y: will then punish for it and not to take advantage ag: any for whch do just provided they behove them selves as they ought for y: future and we hope all persons late had notice and confirme themselves as they will answer y: contrary at their utmost Conscience
