

Within three months or sooner after making thereof Transmitted unto us under the Seals of Maryland for
our approbation or Disallowance of the same as also Duplications of the same by the next Conventiency or if it
happen that During time of Wars and Shipping shall come from the said Province within three months after
the making such Laws Statutes and Ordinances whereby the same may be Transmitted as aforesaid That then the said
Laws Statutes and Ordinances be Transmitted unto us as aforesaid by the next Conventiency after the making thereof
whereby it may offer and in case any or all of them being not before confirmed by us shall at any time be
Disallowed and not approved and so signified by us or our heirs or Successors under our or their Signes manuell and
Signett by Order of our or their Privy Council unto you the said Nathaniell Blackston or to the Comand in Chief
of our said Province for the time being when such and so many of them as shall be Disallowed and not approved
shall from thenceforth cease to be in force and become utterly void and of none Effect any thing to the contrary therof
notwithstanding And to the end that nothing may be passed or done by the said Council or Assembly to the
Prejudice of us our heirs and Successors We do hereby will and ordain that you the said Nathaniell Blackston
shall have a Regalitie Vats in the making and passing of all Laws Statutes and Ordinances as aforesaid that you shall
and may likewise from time to time as you shall Judge it necessary Adjourn Prorogue and Dissolve all General
Assemblies as aforesaid And our will and Pleasure is that you shall and may use the Subligue Seals appointed
or to be appointed by us for the Province of Maryland We do doo further give and grant unto you the said
Nathaniell Blackston full power and authority from time to time and at any time hereafter by your self
or by any to be authorized by you in that behalf to Administer and give the Oathes appointed by Act of Parliament
to be taken instead of the oathes of Allegiance and Supremacy to all and every such persons as you shall
think fitt to be taken at any time or times pass into the said Province or shall be resident or abiding there
and we do hereby further give and Grant unto you full power and Authority with the Advice and Consent
of our said Council to Erect constitute and Establish such and so many Courts of Judicature and Subligue
Justices within the said Province and Territory under your Governour as you and they shall think fitt and necessary
for the hearing and Determining of all Causes as well Criminal as Civil according to Law and Equity and
for Awarding the Execution thereupon with all reasonable and necessary powers Authorities Hoors and privileges
belonging unto them as also to appoint and Commission fitt persons in the severall parts of your Governour
to Administer the oathes appointed by Act of Parliament to be taken instead of the Oathes of Allegiance and
Supremacy and the Test unto such persons as shall be obliged to take the same And likewise require them to
take the same and to be sworn unto and we do hereby authorize and Impower you to constitute
and appoint Judges and in Causes requisite Commissioners of Oyer and Terminer Justices of Peace and
other necessary Officers and ministers in our said Province for the better Administration of Justice and putting
the same in Execution And to Administer or Cause to be Administered unto them such oathes Oathes as are
usually given for the due Execution and performance of Office and place and for the clearing of Truth
in Judiciall Causes And we do further by these presents will and require you to provide Appeals to be
made in Cases of Error from the Courts in Maryland to the Governour and Council there in Civil Causes
Provided the Value of the Cause for which one hundred pounds Next and that Security be first duly given
by the appellatant to answer such Charges as shall be adjudged in Case the first Sentence shall
be affirmed You are not to admit or allow of any Appeals whatsoever to be made from the Governour
and Council to the Assembly But where we do think it absolutely necessary that our Subjects may have
Liberty to appeal unto the Assembly in Cases that may require the same Our will and Pleasure is that if either Party
doe not rest satisfied with the Judgment or Sentence of the Governour and Council They may then Appeals unto us in our
Privy Council Provided the matter in Dispute exceed the Value of three hundred pounds Next and
that such Appeals be made within one Month after Sentence and that Security be likewise given by the
appellatant to answer such Charges as shall be awarded in Case the Sentence of the Governour and Council in
such Appeals be confirmed and Provided also that Execution be not suspended by reason of any such
Appeals unto us and forasmuch as it may not be fitt that Appeals be too frequently and for too small Values
brought brought unto our Governour and Council You shall therefore with the Advice of the said Council
propose a Law to be passed wherein the number and Limitation of Appeals may be limited unto us and Governour
and Council may be settled and restrained in such manner as shall be found most Conducive and Easy for our
Subjects in Maryland And we do hereby give and Grant unto you full power and Authority where you
shall Judge any Offender or Offenders in Criminal matters or for fines or forfeitures due unto us fitt
to be pardoned of our mercy to pardon all such Offenders and remitt all such fines and forfeitures before or after
the taking of the same
