 presents do give and Grant unto our trusty and welbeloved Thomas Lawrence Esquire of
 the Office or Place of Secretary of the Province of Maryland in America the Government
 whereof we have taken into our hands and vnder our immediate care and him the said Thomas
 Lawrence Secretary of the Province of Maryland in America we do make Ordaine and Confirme
 by these presents to have hold & enjoy the said Office or place unto the said Thomas
 Lawrence by himself or his sufficient Deputy during our pleasure and the Residencie of the
 Said Thomas Lawrence in the said Province together with all rights priviledges profits
 perquisites and advantagies to the said Office belonging incident or in any wise appertaining
 and in such manner and forme as any Secretary of any of our Provinces in America for
 or by reason of the exercise and execution of such office or place may lawfully have, receive
 or enjoy And we have Revoked and determined and by these presents do Revoke and determine
 certain Letters Patents vnder Our Great Seal of England bearing date the fifth day of Sept
 ember in the third yeare of the Reigne of us and our late Royall Consort Queen Mary
 wherby the said Office was Granted unto Sir Thomas Lawrence Baronett In witness
 whereof we have caused these our Letters to be made Patents witness Thomas Archi
 Bishop of Canterbury and the rest of the Keypers and Justices of the Kingdom at
 Westminster the twentyeighth day of September in the tenth yeare of our Reigne —

 Greeting Know yee that William Leeds late of the County aforesaid in his lifetime was
 really possessed of several Tracts of Land lying & being in the County aforesaid at the time of his
 death in his last will and Testament did give & Bequeath unto his two Eldest Sons (viz) —
 William Leeds & Michael Leeds all y^e aforesaid Lands and Tenements that he y^e d^e William Leeds was
 then really possessed with all and both the Lawfull heirs of their Bodys. But if the d^e William
 or Michael Leeds they or either of them should die without Lawfull Issue then his or
 thire part to descend to his surviving Brother Edward Leeds. But if the d^e William Leeds
 & Michael should both die without Issue & heirs of their Bodys lawfully begotten then
 then the d^e Lands & Tenements to descend to y^e two younger surviving Brothers —
 Edward Leeds & John Leeds. But y^e Michael Leeds being now dead without Issue and
 for y^e Confirmation of y^e aforesaid will. We y^e d^e William Leeds Edward Leeds & John Leeds —
 having considered that y^e aforesaid will gives John Leeds no part of the aforesaid Lands & Tenements
 which two others should be all living theroford we the d^e William & Edward Leeds
 being willing y^e the d^e John Leeds I should haue an equal part of y^e aforesaid Lands & Tenements
 with vs theroford we the d^e William Leeds Edward Leeds & John Leeds do hereby Covenant
 grant & agree either to go with vs to divide y^e aforesaid Lands & Tenements that so each man
 know his equal share of y^e aforesaid Lands & vs In Order therunto it is Agreed upon by the aforesaid
 that this division bee at a Marsh called y^e Otter hole Marsh belonging to a cove
 that makes Wades Pointe & Runing from thence South & by East untill it meeteth y^e western arm
 of y^e Branch called Cattagle Branch & all y^e lands lying on y^e western side of y^e aforesaid South & by East
 and crook of makes of y^e Branch shall be holden by the d^e Edward Leeds & John Leeds aforesaid to be Equa
 lly divided to y^e proper vs & behoofe of them y^e d^e Edward & John Leeds & their heirs for ever
 the remaining part of y^e aforesaid lands lying on y^e eastern side of y^e aforesaid South & by East line to be & remain
 to y^e sole proper vs & behoofe of y^e d^e Wm. Leeds his heires & assigns for ever In witness Whereof the
 parties above mentioned haue set unto both their hands affixed
