Whereas the above bound Wm Canings hath before the day of the date above written bought had & received of & from the above named John Clemens or his assignes fifty hogshoads of good sound M<sup>st</sup> plantable tobacco in rask upon his the said Wm Canings contract assumpsit & Agroom to pay or cause to be paid unto the said John Clemens his certain attorney & cor assignes after the rate & at the price of foure pounds of Sterling money of England for each & every the said hogshoads of tobacco at the end of six yeares from the day of the said Contract being the seven & twentieth day of June last past Now the Condition of this present obligation is such that if he the said Wm Canings his & adriest & assignes doe & shall in p<sup>er</sup>formance & p<sup>er</sup>formance of the said Contract & Agroom well & truly pay or cause to be paid unto him the said John Clemens his & adriest & assignes the full & entire sume of two hundred pounds of currant Sterling money of England being the full & entire sume of & for the said tobacco on the seven & twentieth day of June which shall be in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand six hundred & eighty being the day agreed on & covenanted by the said Agroom & Contract for the paym<sup>nt</sup> thereof without fraud deceit or further delay or any other p<sup>re</sup>text or evasion to be made touching the same, but according to intent & true meaning in all points then this present obligation shall be void otherwise to remaine & be in full power force & vertue
