 September in the fifth yeare of the Reigne of
 our Sovn Lady Anne by the Grace of God of
 England Scotland France and Ireland Queen
 Defender of the faith &c. Anno Dni 1706
 Between Jos. Wilson of Annapundell City
 Gent. of the one Part and Wm Kidd of Calv.
 County plan. of the otherpart Witnesseth
 that the said Josiah for and in consideration
 of the sume of £ thirty pounds Currant money
 of Maryland to him in hand paid the rec.
 whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and
 therewith to be fully satisfied contented
 & paid hath given granted sold aliend and
 Confirmed and by these presents for himself
 his heires &c. & ad. doth give grant sell
 alien and Confirme unto him the said Wm
 Kidd his heires and astis forever all y^e tract
 or peell of Land calld & knowne by the name
 of Black oak thicket. Situate lying & being in
 Charles County. Beginning at a bounded red oak
 Saplin standing in a fork of Bradsham Creek
 and running thence South two hundred p.
 thence West two hundred p. then north two hundred
 thence with a straight line to y^e first bounded
 tree Cont. & laid out for two hundred and
 fifty a. more or less to have and to hold
 the said tract of Land wth all and singular the
 p^rmisses and appurtenances to him y^e said
