and in Consideration of the full and just sume  
of fifty five pounds Lawfull money of England  
to him in hand paid before y<sup>e</sup> Ensealing and  
delivory of these presents wherof he the  
said W<sup>m</sup> Kidd doth hereby acknowledge —  
himselfe therewith fully satisfied & paid and  
theroof and every part therooof doth Coarly —  
acquitt & honorate and discharge the said Abraham  
Johns his hoires & ad<sup>ors</sup> and assis & every of  
them by these presents Hath given granted
