heretofore granted for or by reason of any writs or alienations
to be not received by the said Edward Somersell or the said
Charles Lord Baltimore or either of them assigned on or
before the first day of August last past before the date
of these presents to have the said to y^e only propriety
and benefit and advantage of them the said Richard
Bennet and James Heath their heirs and assigns
And the said Richard Bennet and James Heath
doe for themselves and for their heirs Executors and
Administrators consent and promise to and with the said
Edward Somersell his Executors and assigns by
these presents that they the said Richard Bennet and
James Heath or one of them their or one of their heirs or
assigns shall and will yearly during the term
of this demer well and truly pay or cause to be paid
unto y^e said Edward Somersell his Executors and
assigns the sum of five hundred pounds sterling
behind and unto or any part thereof for the
space of twenty days next after y^e day on which y^e
same ought to have been paid in any year of
the aforesaid term if the same not having been law-
fully tendered at the place where it ought to be that
