-rectly (to the best of this Affirmant's Knowledge) had
or rec^d. of or from the said Joseph Williams or
any other person or persons w^{ch}soever all or any part
of the Sum of Two hundred & fifty seven pounds & eleven
shillings & nine pence in the said Acc^t. mentioned
but that the same is still justly & truly owing
and unpaid to this Affirmant And we do hereby
further Certify that the said John Tailor did
now before us in Court Seal & as his Act & Deed
deliver to the use of George Ashman of the County
of Ballmore the Letter of Atty assed hereunto
Amexed bearing Date y^e Twentieth day of Janry
Instant for the purposes therein mentioned In faith
