and Sarah his wife do hereby fully & honestly acquit  
& Discharge the <sup>sa</sup> Francis Maulding his Heirs & assigns  
or Exors. Heirs Given Granted Bargaind Sold aliened En-  
loosed and Confirmed as by these p<sup>ts</sup>ents they the <sup>sa</sup> Job &  
Sarah his wife do for them & their Heirs Give Grant  
Bargain Sell Allien Enloose and Confirms unto him the <sup>sa</sup>  
Francis Maulding his Heirs and assigns all that y<sup>e</sup> <sup>sa</sup>  
Tract or parcel of Land called Friends Discovery lying  
in Baltimore County in the Woods being part of Aridge  
called Little Brittain. Beginning at three boundd white  
oaks standing by a branch of the Herring run near  
Thurstons Road and running thence west four hundred  
twoenty nine fethes towards Jouds falls to a boundd  
Hicory standing on a Lovell then from the <sup>sa</sup> Hicory  
South three hundred & eighty fethes to a boundd oak  
standing in a valley near to a branch of Jouds falls  
then East four hundred twoenty nine fethes to a boundd  
white oak then w<sup>th</sup> a direct line to y<sup>e</sup> first bound tree  
Containing & laid out for one thousand Acres more
