I hereby to my son John Dorsey that  
 plantation that Bacon now lives on

 their increase if any: with three Cowes  
 two of feathered Corn &c: as the  
 above said - fourthly to my son Nicholas  
 Dorsey that plantation that negro Tom  
 lives on with one hundred acres of  
 Land next adjoyning with Cowes &c:  
 Corn &c: as the other said above  
 and the said two negroes namely the  
 dom and Hager his wife with their increase  
 if any fifthly my son Benj. Dorsey of  
 piece of Land lying between  
 and Bacon with that piece of cleared  
 ground cleared this yeare and where  
 a quarter God willing will: build at  
 fall next with one hundred acres of Land  
 next adjoyning to it with two negroes  
 namely Robin and Nell with their increase  
 if any with Cowes two Corn &c: spots  
 of the same as the other Brothers of  
 and in case of Death or want of  
 Lawfull heirs of any of my said sons  
 then his or their Land one negro & half  
 Equally divided amongst the surviving  
 Brothers and each son to be pleased on  
 their severall plantations and to receive  
 their severall negroes and other things  
 as above said at the age of sixteen &  
 therto to be kept at work: for himselfe  
 but not to have the Disposition above  
 named. and after my Death to live
