

This Indenture In part made the Twelveth day of february
 in the year of our Lord 1700: Between Richard Hill of Ann
 Arundell County in the province aforesaid Mariner of the
 first part Joseph Hill of the County aforesaid of the second
 part and Henry Hill of Dorchester County in the province
 aforesaid Mariner of the third part. Whereas Richard Hill son
 of Ann Arundell County Esq: & his father of them the
 said Richard Hill Joseph Hill and Henry Hill parties to these
 presents being in his life time seized in his demesne
 as of freehold in severall messuages lands tenements
 woods & hereditaments. But more especially peculiarly
 of and in severall Tracts following w^{ch}: One certain
 Tract or partell of land called Town by Grant lying in
 Ann Arundell County aforesaid on the North side of South river
 in the Woods butted and bounded as in the Originall patent
 bearing date the Tenth day of August in the year of our
 Lord 1684: granted unto Our George by Act of Ann Arundell
 County his Heirs & Assignes for ever is set forth therein
 sayd to be containing layd out for Two hundred &
 fourty acres of land more or less (except and always
 reserved from and out of the said Two hundred & fourty
 acres fifty acres partell of the above written Two hundred
 and fourty acres which the said Richard Hill decessed did
 in his life time grant assigne assigne & convey unto the above
 named Henry Hill party to these presents his Heirs & Assignes
 for ever as in and by a certain Deed by the said Richard Hill
 in his life time for that purpose made relation thereto being
 had may more plainly and at large appear. And of and in
 One other certain Tract or partell of land called the
 addition lying in the woods in the said County between
 Severn river then known by the name of Ann Arundell river
 & South river butted & bounded as in the Originall patent bearing
 date the Twelveth day of february in the year of our Lord
 1684: granted also unto the said George by Act his Heirs & Assignes
 for
