


Barbados, June 7th 1699.

Att Thirty days sight of this my second Bill of Exchange
 my first & third not paid, pray pay or cause to be
 paid unto Cap^t John Howells the sum of four
 hundred and thirty pounds sterling money of England
 and place it to account of your obliging
 Servant Tho^s Hutson Esq^r in John Shippard
 Merchant in London - Pay the content w^{ch} is
 to Thomas Blackwell a bearer w^{ch} is the
 assignment of John Howells - Tho^s Blackwell
 scrivener. Jenkins Notary and Sub. Aron publick by
 Royal Authority Admitt^d and sworn Dwelling in London
 do hereby certify and attest, that at the request of Cap^t
 John Howells of London in chanc^e I did make diligent Enquiry
 on the Exchange of this City and other places after Mr John
 Shippard to whom the Burguall Bill of Exchange w^{ch} is
 the copy is here above written is directed in order to Blayne
 and places and payment of the same, but after all diligence
 used could not find out or hear of any Mr John Shippard or any
 other person whatsoever who would take any the said Bill
 of the said Bill, whereupon I the said Notary at the Request
 afo^r have protested as by these presents I do solemnly protest
 as well against Thomas Hutson Draw^r of the said Bill as all
 other whom it may concern for Exchange and Rechange w^{ch}
 for all with Damages and interest suffered and to be paid
 for want of acceptance and payment of the said Bill
 this Done and Proved in London this Eleventh day of June
 the 1700: And in the Twelfth Year of the Reigne of William
 the third King of England &c
