Att severall days sight of this my first Bill of Exchange
my second and third not paid pray pay or cause to be paid
unto Capt. John Howell or his order the sum of One
hundred Seventy four pounds fourteen shillings Sterling
money of England and please it to account of Your humble
servant Charles Thomas = John Worppfull & Joseph
Hend Merchant in London = Gray pay the content to
Order John Howell.

On the Tenth Day of May Anno Dom 1700 at the request of
Mr. Joseph Howells of London Merchant & Gentleman
Junkie Notary and tabellor publick by Royall authority
Admitted and sworn Dwelling in London and Did Exhibit
the Original Bill of Exchange wherof Mr. Voppy is draw
above written unto Frederick Horn Esq. Son of the
Worppfull & Joseph Horn late deceased and demanding
payment of the content he answered that he would not pay the
Bill for want of effects: which being by me Notary heard &
then protested as by these presents I doe Voluntarily protest
at the request of the said Charles Thomas drawer of the
said Bill for all other whom it may concern for Exchange and
change and for all cost Damages & interests suffered and to be
suffered for want of payment of the said Bill, Thus done &
protsted in London in the presence of Rowley Colborne and
Abraham Handcock Witnesses.
