 To sue Demand and sue for Recover and Receive of and from  
 all and every such person or persons whom he shall or may  
 concern And more especially of and from the said Thomas Hudson  
 and Charles Thomas Merchants of the said Island of Barbadoes for two  
 severall promissed bills of Exchange for such sum or sums of  
 money as by the original of the said bills of Exchange may  
 appear And also all and every other sums and sums of money  
 Good, Wards, Merchandises Effects and things whatsoever Casador  
 shall be due Owning or belonging unto her the said Sarah Blackwell  
 as Executrix of the said Thomas Blackwell dec'd as aforesaid in the  
 Island of Barbadoes as aforesaid for what cause or causes former  
 the said may be due together with all costs Damages and Intrests  
 also Touching the premises to amount comend: And agree  
 as the said attorney shall think fit. Upon request and Request
