This Indenture made the fourth day
of July anno Domini 1200 and in the twelfth
of the reign of our Sovereign Lord William the
first by the Grace of God King of England
Scotland France and Ireland Defender of the
Faith &c. Between Henry Bennett of
Norwich in the County of Norfolk Bachelor
of Geo. Bennett Deed of the said part
and m^r Holland of Cambridg^e County in the
County of Maryland merchant of the other part
witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the
sum of Eighty two pounds and three Shillings
of Lawfull English money to the said Henry
Bennett in hand at or before the date hereof
and Delivery of these presents by the said
Holland well and truly paid the receipt whereof
the said Henry Bennett hath freely
acknowledg^d and hereof and of every part
thereof doth freely acquit and Discharge
the said m^r Holland his Exors and
assignes by these presents to the said
Henry Bennett hath granted bargained sold
aliened and confirmed and by these presents
Doth fully and absolutely Grant bargain
sell aliened and confirmed unto the said
