 that we all who under the seal  
 of our said City have made and  
 confirmed the same before the  
 Mayor of the said City of Norwich and did  
 acknowledge the indentures of bargain  
 and sale hereunto annexed bearing  
 date the fourth Day of this instant month  
 of July to be the act and deed of the  
 said Henry Bonett made and executed  
 by the said town into a Suffolk and  
 in the said indentures named by us  
 of right two pounds and three shillings  
 to the said Henry Hall Bargained and  
 sold by the said Suffolk certain parcels  
 of land called St. James four acre  
 five hundred and more of the appurtenances  
 thereunto belonging in the parsonage of  
 St. James and by the said indentures and  
 duly appeared in witness whereof the  
 said Mayor and the said Henry Hall  
 Common Seal of the said City of  
 Norwich in the fifth year of the reign of King
