This Indenture made the
 thirteenth day of August anno Dni 1700
 and in the 12th year of the reign
 of our Sovereign Lord King the third
 the great of God of England Scotland France
 and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c
 Between Richard Burk of the parrysh
 of St. Giltes in the said County of
 York and also his wife of the one
 part and John Gandy of the parrysh of
 Shephey in the said County of Middlesex
 of the other part witnesses that
 said Richard Burk for and in consideration
 of the sum of one hundred and sixty pounds of
 lawful money of England to him
 in hand paid by the said John Gandy at and before
 the sealing and delivery of these presents
 the receipt whereof the said Gandy
 and himselfe knoweth and thereof
 and of every part thereof both hereby acquit
 release and discharged the said John Gandy
 his heirs Executors and assigns and
 every of them by these presents they the said
 Richard Burk and also his wife have
 each of them their granted bargained sold
 aliened released and confirmed and by
 these presents do and each of them
 doth
