and Zacharias Manswrington of the said County of St^h:
Maries Gent: And Martha his wife the sole surviving
Daughter and Heir of Daniel Devins of the same Count
Plant: Dord: of the other part. Witnesseth that whereas
heretofore that is to say upon the second day of Novemb^r:
in the year of our Lord 1661 William Calvert Esq^r father
of the said Charles by Indenture then made Between
him and the said Daniel Devins & Hugh Manning of the
said County Plant: for divers good Causes & Considerations him
therunto moving did sell & grant to the said Daniel Devins
and Hugh Manning their Heirs & Assignes all the Towne
or Plantacon commonly called and knowne by the name
of Henry James Neck containing two hundred Acres more
or less of the said towⁿ: Calvert the said Land was for him and
his Heirs Descend: Adm^r: & Assignes from all just Reymes &
Demands what soever warranted and do should they paying
yearly four hams or capons on the tenth of Octob^r: at the Mansion
House
