Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the Sum of Ten Shillings of Lawfull monny of England to her the said Elizabeth Copley in hand paid by the sd Norton Bryan at & before the Sealing & Delivery of these p'sents the Receipt whereof she doth hereby acknowledge & herselfe to be therewith fully satisfied and thereof doth acquitt Release & Discharge the said Norton Bryan his heirs & oets Admts & assigns & every of them for ever by these p'sents Have granted Bargained & Sold & by these p'sents doth
