 Lett it having never as we could find any certain
 bounded tree before assigned it and run from
 thence west four hundred and twenty fathoms but
 not finding the bounded tree we continued the
 said West Course two hundred forty five paces
 where Lett Hindan Beale did declare upon
 his oath that a bounded Hickory which he
 bounded by the order of Charles Butler then
 Surveyor for a bounded tree for a tract of
 Land called Catesby and afterwards for a bounded
 tree of Major Lett and Edward Dawson showed
 us two slipped trees which upon his oath he did
 declare the said Lett Hindan Beale showed him
 some years before any difference concerning the
 said tract of land to be the place where the said
 bounded Hickory did stand from thence west did run
 according to pattern South three hundred fathoms
