presents Halk and Doath by my Great
Bergann Bell Reddass Inffooff and Confirms
unto him the said Tho: Dixon his Heir
and assignes for ever so much and such
a Quantity of the said Tract of Land
as shall happen to fall within the
bounds and Lines of a Tract of Land
taken up by one John Williams and
now in the possession of One John
Bristingham to the same more or less
