hundred and forty pounds of good and lawfull money
of England to them in hand paid by the said Chris-
topher Goodland the receipt whereof and of every part
and parcel thereof they the said Abraham Johns
William Cole do hereby respectively declare and
acknowledge and thereof and of every part and
parcel thereof do hereby severally acquit and
respectively acquit & forever discharge
the said Christopher Goodland his heirs &c.
Administrators and Assignes and every of them by their
presents **Have** given granted bargained sold
allotted enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents
do fully clearly acquit discharge and absolutely give
grant bargain sell alien Enfeoff and confirm
unto the said Christopher Goodland his heirs and
Assignes for ever All and every part and parcel
of two tracts of Land Situate and lying on Kent
Island formerly in the County of Kent but now
in
