

By an Act of Assembly in the County of Talbot the one
 Tract of Land called taken up and patented by Thomas
 Marsh and called by the Name of Popshorned Swamp
 and laid out for three hundred Acres more or less
 The other Tract of Land taken up and patented by
 Thomas Bradnoe and called by the Name of
 Broad Oak Swamp and laid out for five
 hundred Acres more or less which said two
 Tracts of Land joining together by several
 Mean Assignments was sold and vested upon
 James Higby of Annapolis County Gentle-
 man And the said James Higby by his deed of Con-
 veyance Indented and enrolled according to Act of
 Assembly in that Case made and provided and
 remaining amongst the Records of the provin-
 cial Court bearing date the fifteenth day of
 May in the year of our Lord one thousand six
 hundred ninety and seven conveyed unto the said
 Abraham Johns and William Cole their heirs and
 Assignes for ever And to And for none other use
 Intent or purpose whatsoever as by the said deed
 of Bargain and Sale or Assignments remaining
 upon Records as aforesaid Relation being thereunto
 had it doth and may more fully and at large
 appear Beginning at an bounded oak Standing
 on the South Side of the eastern Creek and running
 East North east two hundred and fifty Poles and from
 the end of the said Line by a Line drawn South
 South east three hundred fifty five Poles then South
 west One hundred and eighty Poles and from the end of
 the said South west Line by a Line drawn west South west
 three hundred and ninety Poles w^{ch} the Bay then by
