The Indenture made the Eleventh day of May in the
 12th year of our Lord 1702 Between Tho: Brown of the
 County of Ballin four of the one part and Charles
 Carroll of the City of Amsterdam Gent of the other
 part Witnesseth that the sd Tho: for in Consideration
 of the real sum of fifty two thousand two hundred
 pounds of lb to him in hand paid or pounds to be paid
 by the sd Charles the receipt whereof the said
 Tho: doth hereby acknowledge and thereof
 is of every of a good issue of debt lawfully
 made and lawfully received and thereof
 he doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and of every
 part and parcel thereof doth hereby
 fully satisfy and absolutely discharge
 acquit and discharge the said Charles
 his heirs Exors and admrs of all the
 Grants bargains sold aliened disposed
 and to be made as by these presents has the
 said Tho: doth for him and his heirs give
 Grants bargains sold aliened disposed
 confirm unto him the said Charles Carroll
 and to his heirs all the two severall
 tracts or parcels of land the one called the
 Shop and containing four hundred seven
 eight unto the said River of Rye
 the other called Buckingham and containing
 four hundred seven eight unto a
 Swam (Swamp) both in the said
 Liberties lying and being in the County of
 Ballinmore of and now are or late were
 in the possession of the said Thomas
 together with all and singular the dwelling
 out houses ~~the~~ houses garden
 (Stables)
