

This Indenture made the twenty
 eight day of January Anno Dni one
 thousand seven hundred and two and in
 the first year of the reign of our said
 Lady Anne Queen of England Scotland
 France and Ireland Defender of the
 faith etc **BETWEEN** Thomas Larlem
 of Limerick County of the one parts
 and Henry Redley of parish of George
 County of the other parts witnesseth
 That the said Thomas Larlem for and in
 consideration of the sum of one hundred
 and thirty pound Sterling and the said
 two thousand pounds of to be due to him
 in hand paid at the Insisting and delivery
 of these presents the Receipt whereof
 he the said Thomas Larlem doth here by
 acknowledge himselfe therewith to be fully
 satisfied contented and paid and of every
 parte thereof doth here by acquitt and
 discharge the said Henry Redley his heirs
 Ex adm. and assigns by these presents
 hath given granted aliened bargained sold
 disposed and confirmed and by these presents
 doth fully freely and absolutely give grant
 aliened bargain sold disposed and confirmed
 unto the said Henry Redley his heirs and
 assigns for ever all that tract or parcell of
 Land called Larlem his forrest lying in parish
 of George County on the west side of the
 River and beginning at a bounded white Oak
 standing in the line of a parcell of Land
 formerly laid out for Mr Rowell of St Marys
 (County)
