

This Indenture made the  
 Tenth Day of September in the Twenty  
 third year of the Dominion of the right  
 hon<sup>ble</sup> Charles absolute Lord and proprietor  
 of the province of Maryland and Avalon  
 Lord Baron of Baltimore etc and in the  
 year of our Lord God one thousand six hundred  
 and fifty eight **BETWEEN** Robert  
 Carole of the County of Prince Georges  
 of Maryland Gent of the one part and  
 Henry De la Rey Sen of the County of  
 Annapolis in the said province merchant  
 of the other part **WITNESSETH** that  
 whereas my Lord Baltimore by Deed of  
 Grant under his Great Seal was in the  
 said province for granting of Lands there bearing  
 date the Tenth Day of August in the Eighth  
 year of his Majesty's Dominion and in the  
 year of our Lord 1683 did for the Consideration  
 therein mentioned grant unto the said Robert  
 Carole by the name of the said Robert Carole  
 of the County of Prince Georges and to his heirs all that parcel  
 or tract of Land called or known  
 by the name of Cotton Runnals lying and  
 being in the said County (now called George  
 County) one mile from the west side of the  
 North Branch of Potomack River beginning  
 at a bounded place being a bounded tree of the  
 Land of Dr<sup>r</sup> Howell in Gent's standing in the  
 line of a parcel of Land formerly laid out for  
 John Hewerton called Hewertons range and  
 running with the line of the said Land North  
 North west one hundred perches to the Land  
 formerly laid out for Robert Wilson Gent's there  
 (In)
