and necessary party and party to pass
from th^{is} our Kingdoms unto any of our
Colonies Dominions or provinces in America
safely and that he be civilly treated and assisted
upon all occasions whereto he may have
need of the aid and furtherance of our
good Subjects in order to the better Discharge
of the Com^{and} we do hereby give and that
finally having performed the same he be
suffered wth the like freedom to returne
back into th^{is} our Kingdoms w^{ch} at our
Court at St James the 15th Day of June
1702 in the first year of our said
