This Indenture made the Twentieth day of August in the first year of the reign of our Sovereign Lady Anne by the Grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland Queen Defender of the faith etc Anno 1702

Between Wm Esborn of Calvert County in the province of Maryland planter of the one part and Joseph Wilson of Calvert County in the province and planter of the other part witnesseth that the said Wm Esborn for and in consideration for sum of the sum of Eighty pounds current money of England to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Wilson at or before the signing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof by the said Wm Esborn both has by endorsement and thereof therefrom both acquit Exonerated and Discharged the said Joseph Wilson his heirs Executors and Administrators and every of them by these presents as also for down good Consideration sum the said Wm Esborn thereunto moving both parties bargain sold aliened Infeoffed Releas'd and Conferred and by these presents
